Hunspach Reformed KB:*Nicklaus(!)* Ganther from Keffenach, a soldier in the *Königl. Frantzösischen Regiment Fersene*, m. 30 Apr. 1750 Maria Margaretha, daughter of Johannes Dörredinger [q.v.], citizen and *Gerichtsmann* at Ingelsheim.

[Note by compiler: This is a good example of an error in a primary source document. The entry should probably read: Jacob, son of Nicklaus Ganther from Keffenach. In all other records, including the baptismal records, manumission record, and PA records, he is named Jacob.]

Dated 22 Apr. 1790, inventory of Jacob Grosjean of Kirberg and his wife Judith nee Fichter, who had no children. Among the heirs of Judith Fichter was her sister Maria Susanna Fichter of Helleringen who is in America with her husband Jacob Hell.
